







Career Center Services for All ALCO Students *Ongoing*

Visit the Career Center in Building 5 to look at the job vacancy board, get free help with applications, interviewing, resumes, and cover letters. Explore career options, programs of study, technical schools and colleges. Receive assistance with completing financial aid applications. Computers with Internet and Microsoft Office are available. Appointment is not required to see job board, pick up flyers/resource information, and use computers. Appointment may be required to meet one-on-one with an advisor.

ASVAB Testing *February 8*

The ASVAB exam measures student's strengths, weaknesses, and potential for future success. Students explore occupations in line with their interests and skills. Results of the aptitude test enable students to evaluate their skills, estimate performance in academic and vocational endeavors, and identify potentially satisfying careers. Students are encouraged to consider their own work-related values and other important personal preferences as they explore the world of work and learn career exploration skills that will benefit them throughout their work lives. **Note:** *Those taking the test are not required to speak with military recruiters or enlist in the Armed Forces.*

Guest Speaker: African-American History Month *February 13*

Ms. Deloris McMillan, former principal and presently president of the Osceola County NAACP will talk about her experiences as the first black teacher at St. Cloud HS, the history of integration in Osceola County, and the importance of being part of our community and voting.

Career Pathways Orientation *February 15*

All ALCO students who are in ESOL 4—6, & ESOL Academic Skills classes are required to attend one Career Pathways Orientation. During this orientation, you will meet ALCO's Student Support Services Staff and receive information on the following: ALCO programs and services, career exploration, career clusters, introduction to local public schools and their programs of study, a comparison of private and public post-secondary schools, financial aid, and much more. In addition, you will be starting a Career Pathways Plan to help you map your short and long term goals. If you haven't attended this orientation, see your teacher.
